

MCWP Advanced Installer



- Aim:** To further instruct the trainee, over and above the modules required for INSTALLER, on compiling risk assessments and method statements undertaking thorough examinations of the complete installation, on demonstrating the use of various types of Mast Climbing Work Platforms (MCWP) to others and the planning selection and use of MCWP on a particular job site. Also to understand the implications and limitations of MCWP in respect of their use with special platform configuration, non-standard tie arrangements and anchor selection.
- Course Entry Criteria:** As the assembly and use of MCWP can be physically demanding, users should be physically fit and in good health and should, generally, not have problems with eyesight or hearing, heart disease, high blood pressure, epilepsy, fear of heights/vertigo, giddiness/difficulty with balance, impaired limb function, alcohol or drug dependence or psychiatric illness. If you have any problems with literacy or language comprehension, or have any doubts about your fitness to use MCWP, you must bring them to the attention of your employer. This need not preclude you from using MCWP, provided your employer conducts an assessment and is able to put into place adequate measures to take account of any difficulties you may have. If any modules require for this application have been completed more than two years prior to application, then the theory tests for those modules (if any) should be retaken and re-assessed.
- Training Modules:** A total of 6 modules are required, over and above those required for INSTALLER, as listed on 3.1.1. of the IPAF MCWP Operations manual
- Assessment:** Will be by both practical and theoretical test, with a pass requiring an achievement of at least 80% in each assessment. The assessment of each module will be reviewed with the candidate at the end of the training to allow feedback and comments.
- Qualification Issued:** Those who successfully complete the course will receive an IPAF Powered Access Licence (PAL) for *MCWP Advanced Installer*.

Objectives:

At the end of the course the candidate will be:

- Capable of demonstrating the safe operation of a MCWP to intended users of the machine.
- Capable of the use of and demonstrating the correct emergency procedures and systems of a MCWP to enable its safe operation in an emergency.
- Capable of carrying out and demonstrating pre-use/daily checks.
- Able to plan the use of MCWP on a particular site, including location and machine selection, and responsibilities of those involved with the supply and use of MCWP.
- Capable of undertaking risk assessments for typical elements of MCWP installation/dismantle, including hazard identification and risk reduction.
- Capable of compiling method statements for typical elements of MCWP installation/dismantle.
- Able to understand technical instruction and the hazards associated with special platform configurations.
- Able to understand the effects of tie configuration changes, and anchor selection.
- Capable of undertaking a thorough examination of a MCWP installation, identifying existing and potential faults, and writing a report in the prescribed format.

Course Details:

It is suggested that the training and assessment of the required additional modules, over and above those required for INSTALLER, would take 5 days.
Group size of 2 or 4 persons.
