

## MCWP Installer



- Aim:** To instruct the trainee to safely operate and install various types of Mast Climbing Work Platforms (MCWP). To include all aspects of operating the MCWP, the assembly of the platform and controlling/safety devices, installation of mast and ties, and movement of the machine. Further to have knowledge of any local regulations relating to the supply and use of MCWP, risk assessments and method statements, and to be capable of final assembly visual and functional checks.
- Course Entry Criteria:** As the assembly and use of MCWP can be physically demanding, users should be physically fit and in good health and should, generally, not have problems with eyesight or hearing, heart disease, high blood pressure, epilepsy, fear of heights/vertigo, giddiness/difficulty with balance, impaired limb function, alcohol or drug dependence or psychiatric illness. If you have any problems with literacy or language comprehension, or have any doubts about your fitness to use MCWP, you must bring them to the attention of your employer. This need not preclude you from using MCWP, provided your employer conducts an assessment and is able to put into place adequate measures to take account of any difficulties you may have. If any modules require for this application have been completed more than two years prior to application, then the theory tests for those modules (if any) should be retaken and re-assessed.
- Training Modules:** A total of 21 modules are required as listed on 3.3.1. of the IPAF MCWP Operations manual and available on request.
- Assessment:** Will be by both practical and theoretical test, with a pass requiring an achievement of at least 80% in each assessment. The assessment of each module will be reviewed with the candidate at the end of the training to allow feedback and comments.
- Course Format:** This course comprises of both theoretical and practical training, with written and practical assessments.
- Qualification Issued:** Those who successfully complete the course will receive an IPAF Powered Access Licence (PAL) for *MCWP Installer*.

### Objectives:

- Aware of the relevant local Health and Safety regulations, standards, codes and guidance for the design, supply, use and management of MCWP.
- Capable of the safe operation of a MCWP.
- Aware of, and able to use, the correct emergency procedures and systems of a MCWP to enable its safe operation in an emergency.
- Capable of carrying out pre-use/daily checks.
- Capable of carrying out weekly inspections.
- Able to retrieve information from user/manufacturers manuals/safety guidance.
- Capable of assessing the suitability of ground conditions and correctly setting up the MCWP base.
- Capable of manoeuvring a MCWP safely, along a fixed course including corners.
- Able to handle, erect and dismantle mast sections safely.
- Able to remove and reinstall a stability/Top tie and check the security of tie and anchors.
- Aware and familiar with the content of relevant local Health and Safety regulations, standards, codes and guidance for the design, supply, use and management of MCWP.

### Course Details:

Duration of this course is 5 days for trainees with some previous experience of working with MCWP or the installation of powered vertical access equipment.
