

MCWP Operator (Mobile)



Aim: To instruct the trainee to safely operate various types of Mast Climbing Work Platforms (MCWP). To include the movement of the machine, its repositioning, and dismantling and reinstatement of the mast structure to its original configuration in a new position.

Course Entry Criteria: As the assembly and use of MCWP can be physically demanding, users should be physically fit and in good health and should, generally, not have problems with eyesight or hearing, heart disease, high blood pressure, epilepsy, fear of heights/vertigo, giddiness/difficulty with balance, impaired limb function, alcohol or drug dependence or psychiatric illness. If you have any problems with literacy or language comprehension, or have any doubts about your fitness to use MCWP, you must bring them to the attention of your employer. This need not preclude you from using MCWP, provided your employer conducts an assessment and is able to put into place adequate measures to take account of any difficulties you may have. If any modules require for this application have been completed more than two years prior to application, then the theory tests for those modules (if any) should be retaken and re-assessed.

Assessment: Will be by both practical and theoretical test, with a pass requiring an achievement of at least 80% in each assessment. The assessment of each module will be reviewed with the candidate at the end of the training to allow feedback and comments.

- Objectives:** At the end of the course the candidate will be:
- Aware of the relevant local Health and Safety regulations, standards, codes and guidance for the design, supply, use and management of MCWP.
 - Capable of the safe operation of a MCWP.
 - Aware of and able to use the correct emergency procedures and systems of a MCWP to enable its safe operation in an emergency.
 - Capable of carrying out daily pre-use/daily checks and weekly inspection.
 - Able to retrieve information from user/manufacturers manuals/safety guidance.
 - Capable of manoeuvring MCWP safely along a fixed course including travel round corners.
 - Capable of assessing ground conditions and setting out MCWP base.
 - Able to handle and erect / dismantle mast sections and check security of tie and Anchors.
 - Able to remove and reinstall a stability / top tie and check the security of ties and anchors.
- Course Format:** This course comprises of both theoretical and practical training, with written and practical assessments. The assessment of each module will be reviewed with the candidate at the end of the training to allow feedback and comments.
- Qualification Issued:** Those who successfully complete the course will receive an IPAF Powered Access Licence (PAL) for *MCWP Mobile Operator*.
- Course Details:** Duration of this course is 1 day for trainees with previous experience of working from, and assisting in the movement of MCWP. For others 2 days.
