

MCWP Operator



Aim: To provide instructions to a Trainee that will enable him/her to become a qualified operator of various Mast Climbing Work Platforms (MCWP), including safe use practices and knowledge regarding the potential hazards associated with use as well as methods to avoid known hazards post familiarization.

Course Entry Criteria: The assembly and use of MCWP can be physically demanding, users should be physically fit and in good health and should, generally, not have problems with eyesight or hearing, heart disease, high blood pressure, epilepsy, fear of heights/vertigo, giddiness/difficulty with balance, impaired limb function, alcohol or drug dependence or psychiatric illness. If you have any problems with literacy or language comprehension, or have any doubts about your fitness to use MCWP, you must bring them to the attention of your employer. This need not preclude you from using MCWP, provided your employer conducts an assessment and is able to put into place adequate measures to take account of any difficulties you may have.

Training Modules:

- Basic MCWP Awareness, Regulations & Guidelines
- MCWP Components and terminology
- Product Specific - Operational Controls
- Product Specific - Emergency Systems
- Pre-use Daily Checks

Assessment: Will be by both a practical and a theoretical test, with a pass requiring an achievement of at least 80% in each assessment. The assessment of each module will be reviewed with the candidate at the end of the training to allow feedback and comments.

Objectives:

At the end of the course the trainee will be:

- Aware of the relevant local Health and Safety regulations, standards, codes and guidance for the design, supply, use and management of MCWP.
- Capable of the safe operation of a MCWP.
- Aware of, and able to use, the correct emergency procedures and systems of a MCWP to enable its safe operation in an emergency.
- Capable of carrying out pre-use/daily checks.

Course Format:

This course comprises of both theoretical and practical training, with written and practical assessments.

Qualification Issued:

Those who successfully complete the course will receive an IPAF Powered Access Licence (PAL) for *MCWP Operator*.

Course Details:

It is suggested that training and assessment of the required modules would take 1/2 day including theory and practical sessions.
